Membership of Indian Geological Congress
Relevant excerpts from Memorandum and Articles of Indian Geological Congress
(Registered under Societies Registration Act 1860)

Art 4. **Membership and Categories of Members of the Association. There shall be the following categories of members:-**

Life Members
Annual Executive Members
Student Members
Honorary Members
Institutional Members
Subscriber

Art 4.1 **Executive Members:** Any person shall be eligible for election as on Executive Member (M.I.G.C.) provided that he possesses the following qualifications:

A degree or diploma in Geology, Applied Geology, Geophysics, Geosciences, Petroleum Engineering, Mining Engineering, Civil Engineering, Hydrology, Environmental Sciences, Geography or any other allied fields of earth sciences, or engineering, from a university, or institution, recognized by the UGC, AICTE or AIU.

Art 4.1.1 **Relaxation in Qualification:** Qualification for the eligibility for election specified in Articles 4.1 and 4.2 may be relaxed in special cases at the discretion of the Executive Council, provided the person has adequately contributed towards the development and progress of research in areas of the earth science, or, its application towards exploration and exploitation of the Earth's resources.

Art 4.1.2 **Life Members:** Any Executive Member may become life member as per Article 5.

Art 4.2 **Student Member:** Any person shall be eligible for election as student member provided that he is aged below 28 years and possesses basic quantification as prescribed in Article 4.1 and is pursuing higher studies in a recognised university /institution or a person undergoing training in these subjects. Student member shall not have voting rights and shall receive only restricted publications free of cost.

Art 5. **Life Composition:**

Art 5.1 A member of twenty years continuous membership standing, who has paid all his dues to the Congress, shall automatically become a Life Member.

Art 5.2 Any member can become a Life Member by paying a lump sum amount ten times the annual fee for membership after he has paid his admission fee. This may be paid in a single sum, or, in instalments within a period of one year.

Art 5.3 Any member may also compound for all the future payments of the above compounding fee, less 1/4th of the total subscription he may have already paid, provided that under no circumstances, shall the compounding fee be reduced to less than five times the annual fee for the members.

Art 7.1 **Membership Fees** – Every member, other than Life Member or Institutional Member, shall pay annual subscription as specified in Article 7.2. The annual subscription shall become due on 1st January of each year. Any person who fails to pay the subscription on or before the 30th June in any year, shall lose the membership of the Congress for that year.
